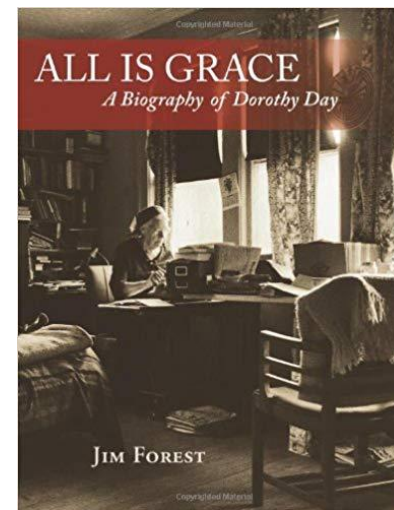
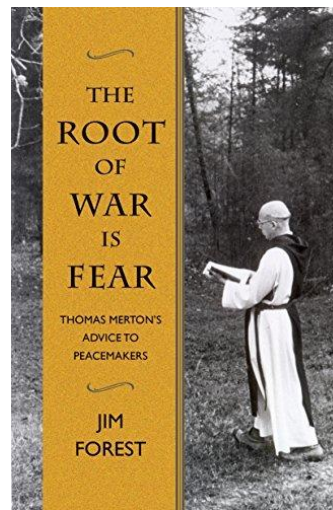
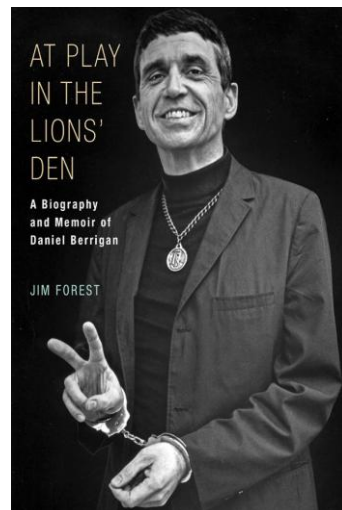


*Jim Forest has been a tireless worker for peace since the early 1960s when he was co-founder of the Catholic Peace Fellowship.*
